Scholarship Application



Scholarship Applications must be received electronically or postmarked by *April 15, 2026*.

The Idaho State Grange Foundation will award one \$1000 scholarship this year to a deserving student who will be attending a four-year college/university, two-year Community College, or technical school. Scholarship applications are available online at idahostategrange.org. Idaho State Grange may award more than one scholarship in lower amounts of scholarships depending the number of applications.

Scholarship Requirements

- Applicants can be Grange members, a relative of a Granger, or a Non-Member. Non-Member must be recommended by a Granger and submit a letter of reference by the Grange member making the recommendation.
- Scholarship is available for graduating high school seniors, or continuing four-year college/university, two-year Community College, or technical school students.
- Idaho State Grange scholarships are available only to undergraduate students.

How to Apply

- Applications must be **typed, printed, and signed**.
- A check list of the required application materials for a complete application should be included.
